## **Fish Depredation Research Queensland**

Fish swabbing instructions.

- 1. Remove swab from snap lock bag. Take care to only touch the green stem with your hands (not the white tip).
- 2. Rub the white tip of the swab gently all over the surface of the bite wound of the depredated fish.
- 3. After swabbing the fish, the swab tip should look clear and not be covered with a lot of blood or fish flesh.
- 4. After swabbing, place the swab tip first into the small vial provided that contains ethanol for preservation. Keep the vial out of reach of young children.
- 5. Using the pen provided, complete the details on the label of the snaplock bag, put the vial in the snaplock bag and store in a cool place until returned to the researcher in the reply paid envelope.
- 6. Send photo of the depredated fish along with the time and date corresponding with the label to jaeden.vardon@research.usc.edu.au
